2. I have no fear or anxiety. I trust in the Lord with all my heart.

3. I walk by faith and not by sight. What God has said is more real to me than what I can see.

2 Corinthians 5:7; Hebrews 11:1; Romans 4:20-21

4. My faith is growing, because faith comes by hearing the Word of God. I feed my spirit on His truth daily.

Romans 10:17; Jude 20; Colossians 3:16

5. I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. I come boldly to the throne of grace.

2 Corinthians 5:21; Hebrews 4:16; Romans 5:1

6. I am healed by the stripes of Jesus. Sickness and infirmity have no legal right to my body.

7. All my needs are met according to God's riches in glory. I do not lack any good thing.

8. I have the mind of Christ. I take every thought captive and refuse every lie of the enemy.
