Who I Am In Christ

SCRIPTURES AND DECLARATIONS

These declarations and scriptures were pulled from a series of prayers and declarations I have used over time. Read these declarations aloud. Speak them over yourself in faith, not according to how you feel in the moment but according to what God's Word says about you. What you consistently confess, you begin to believe. What you believe shapes your identity and your freedom.

Take one section a day, or one declaration a day, and let it settle in your spirit before moving on. If the Holy Spirit stops you on a verse, linger there. All Scripture is quoted from the New International Version.

PART 1

I Am Accepted

1. I am God's child.

John 1:12 Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God.

Romans 8:14-15 because those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father."

Galatians 3:26 You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.

2. I am lavished with the Father's love.

1 John 3:1 See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!

3. I am a friend of Jesus Christ.

John 15:15 I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you.

4. I have been justified.

Romans 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

5. I am united with the Lord and I am one with Him in spirit.

1 Corinthians 6:17 But he who unites himself with the Lord is one with him in spirit.

6. I have been bought with a price and I belong to God.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body.

7. I am a member of Christ's body.

1 Corinthians 12:27 Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it.

8. I have been chosen by God, adopted as His child, and blessed with every spiritual blessing in Christ.

Ephesians 1:3-8 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love he predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will, to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves. In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace that he lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding.

9. I am an heir with the Father and a joint heir with Christ.

Galatians 4:6-7 Because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba." So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, God has made you also an heir.

Romans 8:17 Now if we are children, then we are heirs, heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.

10. I have been redeemed and forgiven of all my sins.

Colossians 1:13-14 For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

11. I am complete in Christ.

Colossians 2:9-10 For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, and you have been given fullness in Christ, who is the head over every power and authority.

12. I have direct access to the throne of grace through Jesus Christ.

Hebrews 4:14-16 Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has gone through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are, yet was without sin. Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

13. I am a saint.

Ephesians 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, to the saints in Ephesus, the faithful in Christ Jesus.

1 Corinthians 1:2 to the church of God in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus and called to be holy, together with all those everywhere who call on the name of our Lord Jesus Christ their Lord and ours.

Philippians 1:1 Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus, to all the saints in Christ Jesus at Philippi, together with the overseers and deacons.

14. I am chosen of God, holy and dearly loved.

Colossians 3:12 Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.

1 Thessalonians 1:4 For we know, brothers loved by God, that he has chosen you.

15. I am fearfully and wonderfully made.

Psalms 139:13 For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made.

PART 2

I Am Secure

16. I am free from condemnation.

Romans 8:1 Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

17. I am assured that God works for my good in all circumstances.

Romans 8:28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

18. I am free from every accusation brought against me, I am more than a conqueror, and nothing can separate me from the love of God.

Romans 8:31-39 What, then, shall we say in response to this? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all, how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things? Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies. Who is he that condemns? Christ Jesus, who died, more than that, who was raised to life, is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? As it is written: "For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered." No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

19. I have been established, anointed, and sealed by God.

2 Corinthians 1:21-22 Now it is God who makes both us and you stand firm in Christ. He anointed us, set his seal of ownership on us, and put his Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.

20. I am hidden with Christ in God, and He is my life.

Colossians 3:1-4 Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.

21. I am confident that God will complete the good work He started in me.

Philippians 1:6 being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

22. I am a citizen of heaven.

Philippians 3:20 But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Saviour from there, the Lord Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 2:19 Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens, but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household.

23. I have not been given a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and a sound mind.

2 Timothy 1:7 For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline.

24. I am born of God and the evil one cannot touch me.

1 John 5:18 We know that anyone born of God does not continue to sin; the one who was born of God keeps him safe, and the evil one cannot harm him.

25. Greater is He who is in me than he who is in the world.

1 John 4:4 greater is he who is in you than he who is in the world.

26. I am saved by grace.

Ephesians 2:8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith, and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God.

PART 3

I Am Significant

27. I am a branch of Jesus Christ, the true vine, and a channel of His life.

John 15:5 I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.

John 15:1-2 I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful.

28. I have been chosen and appointed by Christ to bear fruit.

John 15:16 You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit, fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you whatever you ask in my name.

29. I am God's temple and the temple of the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 3:16 Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit lives in you?

30. I am seated with Jesus Christ in the heavenly realm.

Ephesians 2:6 And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus.

31. I am God's workmanship, created in Christ for good works.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

32. I may approach God with freedom and confidence.

Ephesians 3:12 In him and through faith in him we may approach God with freedom and confidence.

33. I can do all things through Christ, who strengthens me.

Philippians 4:13 I can do everything through him who gives me strength.

34. I am a partaker of a heavenly calling.

Hebrews 3:1 Therefore, holy brothers, who share in the heavenly calling, fix your thoughts on Jesus, the apostle and high priest whom we confess.

35. I am a partaker with Christ and share in His life.

Hebrews 3:14 We have come to share in Christ if we hold firmly till the end the confidence we had at first.

36. I am one of God's living stones, being built up in Christ as a spiritual house.

1 Peter 2:5 you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

37. I am a prisoner of Christ.

Ephesians 3:1 For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for the sake of you Gentiles.

Ephesians 4:1 As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received.

PART 4

I Am a New Creation

38. I am a new creation in Christ; old things have passed away and all things have become new.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!

39. I am in Christ.

Galatians 3:26-28 You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus, for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

40. I am born again by the Spirit of God.

John 3:3-6 In reply Jesus declared, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again." "How can a man be born when he is old?" Nicodemus asked. "Surely he cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb to be born!" Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit."

41. I am the righteousness of God in Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

42. I am a slave of righteousness.

Romans 6:18 You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness.

43. I am enslaved to God.

Romans 6:22 But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life.

44. I am righteous and holy.

Ephesians 4:24 and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

45. I am filled with the divine nature of Christ and escape the corruption that is in the world through lust.

2 Peter 1:4 Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature and escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires.

46. I am a child of light.

1 Thessalonians 5:5 You are all sons of the light and sons of the day. We do not belong to the night or to the darkness.

47. I am redeemed by the blood of the Lamb.

Revelation 5:9 And they sang a new song: "You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slain, and with your blood you purchased men for God from every tribe and language and people and nation."

48. I am an overcomer, because everyone born of God overcomes the world.

1 John 5:4 for everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith.

PART 5

I Am Sent

49. I am the salt of the earth.

Matthew 5:13 You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled by men.

50. I am the light of the world.

Matthew 5:14 You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden.

51. I am reconciled to God and am an ambassador of reconciliation for Him.

2 Corinthians 5:18-19 All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation.

52. I am a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation.

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

53. I always triumph in Christ and release His fragrance in every place.

2 Corinthians 2:14 But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumphal procession in Christ and through us spreads everywhere the knowledge of him.

54. I am an alien and a stranger to this world.

1 Peter 2:11 Dear friends, I urge you, as aliens and strangers in the world, to abstain from sinful desires, which war against your soul.

55. I am the devil's enemy.

1 Peter 5:8 Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

56. I am a true worshiper who worships the Father in spirit and in truth.

John 4:24 God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth.

57. I am part of the Bride of Christ and am making myself ready for Him.

Revelation 19:7 Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory! For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready.
